# 2024 WELLNESS PROGRAM

## \$150 Biometric Screening

A biometric screening includes bloodwork (cholesterol levels, triglycerides, glucose) and vital signs (height, weight, waist circumference, blood pressure). Starting January 26, 2024, log on to <a href="My.QuestForHealth.com">My.QuestForHealth.com</a> (enter registration key DVHT) to schedule an appointment at a Quest lab or on-site event or download your unique Physician Results Form to complete with your primary doctor or at the DVHT Health Center.

### Incentives

#### \$150 Colonoscopy

Enrollees age 45 and over are eligible. Cologuard® colon cancer tests accepted. Proof of procedure required. For those under 45, a physician letter is required stating medical necessity for preventive screening.

#### \$100 Health Education

Attend at least 4 hours of hospital-based education (classes or programs) on topics to improve personal health. Eligible virtual classes offered through the Health Trust are posted at <a href="https://www.dvfrusts.com/events">www.dvfrusts.com/events</a>. Proof of education hours required for classes completed through hospital-based programs.

#### \$50 Women's Well Visit

Annual visit for female health and/or preventive pap smear. Proof of procedure required.

#### \$50 Mammogram

Enrollees age 40 and over are eligible. Proof of procedure required. For those under 40, a physician letter is required stating medical necessity for preventive screening.

## Reimbursements

#### Up to \$300 Gym Membership

Exercises classes, personal training, digital exercise programs, online activity apps, and traditional fitness facilities qualify. Up to \$75 reimbursement for each quarter of the calendar year (i.e. Jan to Mar, Apr to June, July to Sep, and Oct to Dec) in which at least 12 workouts are completed. One submission per calendar year with proof of payment and workouts to receive reimbursement.

#### Up to \$200 Race Event Registration

Multiple submissions accepted per year. Proof of payment and registration required. Maximum annual reimbursement \$200.

Up to \$200 WWV (formerly Weight Watchers)
In-person or online WW programs. Proof of payment and participation (at least 3 touchpoints per month) required.

#### Up to \$25 Bike (Sport) Helmet

Dependent children are also eligible to participate. Proof of payment required.

2024 Health Trust incentives and reimbursements must be earned between January 1 and December 31, 2024. Submissions are accepted from current Health Trust enrollees and their covered spouses through January 10, 2025. Enrollees whose Health Trust coverage terminates in 2024 must submit complete incentive and reimbursement requests no later than two weeks after their coverage termination date to be eligible for incentives/reimbursements in 2024. One submission is permitted per incentive/ reimbursement per calendar year unless otherwise indicated above. Incentives and reimbursements totaling \$600 or more in a calendar year shall result in a Form-1099 being mailed to the member. Proof of procedure is most easily obtained as an Aelna Explanation of Benefits (EOB), available by logging in to <a href="https://www.aelna.com">www.aelna.com</a>. Please allow up to 6-8 weeks for processing. Completing your biometric screening is easy and convenient. You will receive current lab results that you can share with your doctor and a \$150 incentive for participating. We hope you take advantage of this free service.

- Form needs to include all required screening values and signatures.

Your biometric screening must be completed between January 1 and December 31, 2024 in order to qualify for the 2024 Biometric Screening incentive. Fast 9-12 hours prior to screening. Take any regularly scheduled medications as usual. Drinking water is permissible and recommended during the fasting period. You will receive an email when your results are ready to view online. Your printed report will arrive in the mail 2-3 weeks after your screening, followed shortly thereafter by your incentive check.



#### Notice Regarding Wellness Programs

The Delaware Valley Health Trust (the "Health Trust") makes a voluntary wellness program available to all employees covered through a Health Trust medical plan and their covered spouses. These programs are administered according to federal rules permitting employer-sponsored wellness programs that seek to improve employee health or prevent disease, including the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008, and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, as applicable, among others.

The Health Trust's wellness program offerings are all participatory-based. This means that to qualify for the associated financial incentive, you only need to participate in the designated activity rather than achieve a certain/specific health outcome. The annual financial incentives and reimbursements available under the wellness program are as follows:

Biometrics Screening Incentive – \$150	Gym Membership Reimbursement – up to \$300.
Colonoscopy Incentive \$150	Fitness Race Reimbursement – up to \$200
Hospital-Based Health Education Incentive – \$100	Weight Watchers Reimbursement up to \$200
Women's Well Visit Incentive – \$50	Bicycle Helmet Reimbursement – up to \$25
Mammogram Incentive – \$50	

As indicated in the above chart, included in this wellness program is an opportunity for each eligible participant to complete a biometric screening, which is a blood test that obtains data to identify and inform an individual if they have or are at risk of developing a chronic condition (e.g., heart disease, diabetes). You are not required to participate in the blood test or other medical examinations. Although you are not required to participate in the biometric screening, only eligible participants who do so will receive the associated financial incentive. The information from your biometric screening will be used to provide you with information to help you understand your current health and potential risks, and may also be used to offer you wellness services through the Health Trust, such as wellness coaching or counseling. You also are encouraged to share your results or concerns with your own doctor.

The Health Trust is required by law to maintain the privacy and security of your personally identifiable health information. The Health Trust will receive aggregate information collected pursuant to a biometric screening, which will be used to better design wellness programing based on identified health risks and may be shared with your employer upon request (but only if the group consists of at least 40 participants). The Health Trust will never disclose any of your personal identifiable health information either publicly or to the employer, except as expressly permitted by law. Medical information that personally identifies you that is provided in connection with the wellness program will not be provided to your employer and may never be used to make decisions regarding your employment.

Your health information will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or otherwise disclosed except to the extent permitted by law to carry out specific activities related to the wellness program, and you will not be asked or required to waive the confidentiality of your health information as a condition of participating in the wellness program or receiving an incentive. Anyone who receives your information for purposes of providing you services as part of the wellness program will abide by the same confidentiality requirements. The only individual(s) who will receive your personally identifiable health information is (are) providers, professional partners of the Health Trust and Health Trust personnel in order to provide you with services under the wellness program.

In addition, all medical information obtained through the wellness program that is stored electronically will be encrypted, and no information you provide as part of the wellness program will be used in making any employment decision. Appropriate precautions will be taken to avoid any data breach, and in the event a data breach occurs involving information you provide in connection with the wellness program, we will notify you immediately.

You may not be discriminated against in employment because of the medical information you provide as part of participating in the wellness program, nor may you be subjected to retaliation if you choose not to participate.
