Additional material demonstrating the contractor's experience and capability may accompany the completed forms. The County of Elk reserves the right to seek clarification and supplementary information from contractor as it decides is necessary to judge the qualifications.

For the proposed general contractor and the trades listed below, the contractor and proposed subcontractors must have a minimum of ten (10) years experience in the completion of substantial restoration projects completed in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation. Where the proposed general contractor will also complete the work on one or more of the trades listed below with its own forces, a separate form shall be submitted for the trade. If a firm is newly organized, the Architect and the Owner will consider the experience of the personnel comprising the newly organized firm, and their reputation in the field of building restoration.

The bidder authorizes the Architect and the Owner to verify the references listed below. Failure to meet the foregoing criteria or information demonstrating poor job performance shall disqualify the prospective bidder from submitting a bid.
